Subject : De-novo Determination of the tariff for power purchase and
other issues.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to this department letter of even number dated 12th February, 2018 on the subject cited above and to say that the State Government feels that there is urgent need to revive the Small Hydro Power Sector in the State in view of a large number of allotted SHPs having not taken off or having come under stress due to various reasons. The Electricity Act, 2003 also mandates that the generation of electricity from renewable sources of energy is to be encouraged by providing suitable measures. The development of Small Hydro Power Sector results in inclusive growth of the State and also helps in economic upliftment of the remote areas of the State. The speedy development of the hydro projects is therefore in larger public interest.

The Hydro Power Policy of the State therefore requires suitable modifications to encourage the investors to implement the project allotted to them. The Government after careful consideration has
