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**PUBLIC NOTICE INVITING SUGGESTIONS/OBJECTIONS**

**In the matter of:**  
**Petition No. 11 of 2021**

Himachal Pradesh State Electricity Board Limited (hereinafter referred to as the “the HPSEBL”) has submitted to the HPERC, Second Annual Performance Review for 4<sup>th</sup> MYT Control Period(FY20-24), determination of Tariff for FY22 and True-up for uncontrollable parameters of FY19 on 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2020. Further, HPSEBL vide MA No. 20/2021 dated 18.02.2021 has filed True-up for uncontrollable parameters of FY20, True-up of controllable parameters for 3<sup>rd</sup> MYT Control Period (FY 2014-15 to FY 2018-19), Additional system improvement schemes including EHV schemes for inclusion in the 4<sup>th</sup> MYT Control Period for its Distribution Business under section 62, 64 and 86 of the Electricity Act, 2003. The Commission raised preliminary queries on the petition vide letter No. HPERC-F(1)-20/2020-2407-08 dated 21.12.2020. HPSEBL submitted reply to these queries vide MA No. 9/2021 dated 23.01.2021. The Commission raised further set of queries/ shortcomings to HPSEBL vide letter No. HPERC-F(1)-20/2020- 3040 dated 11.02.2021. HPSEBL submitted reply to these queries vide MA No. 38/2021 dated 15.03.2021. The salient features of the petition have been published by the HPSEB Ltd. in the newspapers i.e. ‘Times of India’ and ‘Dainik Bhaskar’ on 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 and again on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 in ‘Hindustan Times’ and ‘Divya Himachal’. The full text of the petition under consideration is available on HPSEBL’s website [www.hpseb.in](http://www.hpseb.in). Through this Petition, HPSEBL has projected an Annual Revenue Requirement of Rs. 5642.04 crores for FY21-22 which is Rs. 257.94 crores higher as compared to the ARR of Rs. 5384.1 crores for FY 20-21 approved by the Commission in its order dated June 06, 2020. The total revenue requirement of HPSEBL for FY21-22; along with true ups is Rs. 5491.34 crores. This amounts to an increase of Rs. 251.34 crores over and above the approved Annual Revenue Requirement of FY 20-21.

The Annual Revenue Requirement of the HPSEBL is required to be approved after exercising prudence check by the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (hereinafter referred to as “the Commission” or “the HPERC”) in accordance with the Electricity Act, 2003, the National Tariff Policy, the HPERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Wheeling Tariff and Retail Supply Tariff), 2011 and other statutory provisions.

As required under Section 64(3) of the Electricity Act, 2003, the HPERC hereby invites suggestions and objections in the determination of ARR and fixation of Tariff from the interested parties. Suggestions/objections on the issues together with relevant data, details and copies of documents, if any, in support of the suggestions/objections, be sent by date **09<sup>th</sup> April, 2021** to the Secretary, Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission, Vidyut Aayog Bhawan, Block No, 37, SDA Complex, Kasumpti, Shimla-09 alongwith proof of service of the same to the Executive Director (Personnel) HPSEB Ltd., Vidyut Bhawan, Shimla-171004. The suggestions / objections shall be filed in English or Hindi. The suggestions/objections should be filed in two copies and should carry the full name, postal address with pin code number, fax number and email address, if any, of the person sending the suggestions/objections. Alternatively the suggestions/ objections can also be filed through email to the Commission ([secy-hperc@hp.gov.in](mailto:secy-hperc@hp.gov.in)) and HPSEBL ([cecomm@hpseb.in](mailto:cecomm@hpseb.in) and [edp@hpseb.in](mailto:edp@hpseb.in)) along with a hard copy to the Commission and to HPSEBL.

The HPSEBL shall submit replies to the suggestions/objections on affidavit with 9 copies to the HPERC by **17<sup>th</sup> April, 2021**, one copy of which shall also be sent to the individual objectors in hard copy as well as through mail. The objectors shall submit rejoinder, if any, to the Commission with a copy to the HPSEBL by **23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2021**.

The public hearing in the matter shall be held on **28<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 at 11.30 A.M.** onwards in the Commission’s Court Room at Shimla, wherein the Objectors can present their cases in the proposed hearing. Stakeholders in general, may also participate in the hearing.
