- Applicant

The Applicant respectfully submits as under: -

- 1. Himachal Pradesh State Electricity Board Limited (HPSEBL) is a deemed licensee under first provision of Section 14 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for distribution and supply of electricity in the state of Himachal Pradesh. Consequent to the enactment of the Electricity Act, 2003 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), the process of approval of proposed tariffs is vested with the State Commission.
- Based on the provisions of Section 62 of the Act and in compliance with the directives of the Commission on the matter, HPSEBL is filing the current petition, for determination of Average Pooled Power Purchase Cost for FY 2019-20.

Chlef Engineer (Comm.) HPSEBL Voyut Bhawar Shimla-4 The petition pertains to determination of Average Pooled Power Purchase Cost (APPC) for the financial year 2019-20 in accordance with regulation 5(1)(c) of the CERC (Terms and Conditions for Recognition and Issuance of Renewable Energy Certificate for Renewable Energy Generation) Regulations, 2010 amended from time to time.

HPSEB Limited submits that while nearly all the components of power purchase cost are determined by CERC & HPERC in advance, the Average Pooled Power Purchase Rate (APPC Rate) is being determined by HPERC on year on year basis and accordingly the HPSEB Limited is filing the present petition before the Hon'ble HPERC for determination of APPC rates for FY 2019-20.

The meaning of Pooled Cost of Purchase is as given under the Explanation to regulation 5(1)(c) of CERC ((Terms and Conditions for recognition and issuance of Renewable Energy Certificate for Renewable Energy Generation) Regulations 2010.

Thus the meaning stipulates that the 'Pooled cost of Purchase' is the weighted average pooled price at which Distribution Licensees has purchased electricity in the previous year from:-

- (i) long term suppliers
- (ii) short term suppliers
- (iii) includes own generation but excludes renewable energy sources;

The Purchase quantum and costs for FY 19 are provisional as the details of bills from some of ISTS sources are yet to be received.

In view of above, the Average pooled power purchase cost is computed for FY 20 electricity purchased in FY 19 and in accordance with the following:-

- (1) The arrears pertaining to past periods, which were paid in FY 2018-19, have been excluded as these are not recurring in nature.
- (2) Unscheduled Interchange (UI) has also not been included in line with the philosophy approved by the Hon'ble Commission in APPC order for FY 2012-13.
- (3) The PGCIL/ Transmission Charges/ ULDC/ Other Charges have also been excluded in line with the philosophy approved by the Hon'ble Commission in APPC order of 2012-13.
- (4) The approved rates of Own generating stations have been taken from Multi Year Tariff Order for 3rd control period from dated 10.06.2014 for Generation Business of HPSEBL.
- (5) The Forward (inward) Banking at zero cost has been considered as approved by Hon'ble Commission in previous order.
- (6) The power from Shanan (1 MW) HEP has been considered at zero cost as the bills have not been accepted by HPSEBL due to purchase rate dispute.
- (7) Methodology laid down in the Commission's Orders dated 16.07.2012


