

HIMACHAL PRADESH ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION, SHIMLA

NOTIFICATION

Shimla, the 27th February, 2020.

No. HPERC-B(3)-1/2011-705-Vol-VI.-WHEREAS the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions of Service of Staff) Regulations, 2013, published in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh on 22nd April, 2013, provides that the Commission may make appropriate provisions for promoting the existing employees appointed on regular basis in the Commission within overall sanctioned strength and the provisions for promotion have been made for almost all category of employees in the Commission;

AND WHEREAS there is no promotional avenue available to the Engineering cadre in the Commission, therefore, it necessitates the Commission, to specify the terms and conditions, as per the provisions of sub-regulation (1) of Regulations 5 of HPERC, Staff Regulations, 2013 to fill up the post of the Director (Technical Analysis) by promotion from amongst the incumbent of the post of the Joint Directors /Deputy Directors of engineering cadre. The Dept. of MPP & Power, Govt., of HP has already conveyed the approval to fill up the post of Director (TA) through promotion from amongst eligible incumbent of the Commission, vide letter No. MPP –A(7)-1/2000-III dated 4th October, 2016 and further State Govt., has also accorded approval for one time relaxation in essential qualification of B.E. (Electrical), vide letter No. MPP-B(15)-8/2018-Loose dated 16.09.2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (zk) of sub-section (2) of Section 181, read with sub-sections (2) and (3) of Section 91 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Act No. 36 of 2003), also read with Section 21 of General Clause Act, 1897 (10 of 1897), and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Commission proposes to amend the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions of Service of Staff) Regulations, 2013, published in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh on 22nd April 2013, and as required by sub-section (3) of Section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003 and rule 3 of the Electricity (Procedures for Previous Publications) Rules, 2005, the draft amendment regulations are hereby published for information to all the person likely to be affected thereby; and notice is hereby given that the said draft regulations shall be taken into consideration after expiry of thirty (30) days from the date of notification together with any objections or suggestions which may within the aforesaid period be received in respect thereto.

DRAFT REGULATIONS

1. Short title and commencement.-(1) These Regulations may be called the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions of Service of Staff) (Second Amendment) Regulations, 2020.

(2). These Regulations shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh.

2. Insertion in PART-II of the Schedule-II.- In PART-II of the Schedule-II of the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions of Service of Staff) Regulations, 2013, after item at serial number 10, the following item at serial number 11 shall be inserted, namely:-

(Technical
Analysis) | Promotion from amongst the Joint Directors/Deputy Directors appointed on regular basis in the Commission, having degree in Electrical/Mechanical engineering or equivalent, and having 20 years experience dealing in the matters relating to electricity supply and transmission/distribution or in the regulatory affairs of power sector or in both, as specified for the post of Director (TA) in PART-I of the Schedule-II of these regulations and out of total 20 years 14 years shall be regular service on the posts of Deputy Directors and above levels.” |
