PUBLIC NOTICE INVITING SUGGESTIONS/OBJECTIONS In the matter of

Petition No. 31/2019 alongwith MA No. 15/2019

The Himachal Pradesh Power Transmission Corporation Limited (hereinafter referred to as the "the HPPTCL") has filed the petition No. 31/2019 on dated 30.11.2018 for approval of Business Plan and determination of Tariff for the 4th Multi-Year Tariff Control Period (FY2019-20 to FY2023-24), before the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission" or "the HPERC") under Section 62 read with Section 86 of the Electricity Act,2003 and regulation 37 and 38 of HPERC (Terms & Conditions for Determination of Transmission Tariff) Regulations, 2011 and subsequent amendments carried there under. The HPPTCL has submitted further details through MA No. 15/2019 on dated 28.01.2019 before the HPERC. The salient features of the petition were published by the HPPTCL in the newspapers i.e. "Dainik Bhaskar" and "The Tribune" on 02.03.2019 and again on 09.03.2019 in Dainik Bhaskar.

The full text of the petition, under consideration, can be obtained from the offices of the General Manager, HPPTCL on payment of Rs. 1500/-. Interested parties are also free to see, examine and inspect the detailed compilation at these offices of HPPTCL during office hours on any working day. As required under Section 64(3) of the Electricity Act, 2003, the HPERC hereby invites suggestions and objections in the matter from the interested parties. Suggestions/objections on the issues together with relevant data, details and copies of documents, if any, in support of the suggestions/objections, be sent to the Secretary, Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission, Vidyut Aayog Bhawan, Block No. 37, SDA Complex, Kasumpti, Shimla-171009 alongwith proof of service of the same to the Deputy General Manager (C&M), HPPTCL, Himfed Bhawan, Panjari, Shimla-171005 by 30th March, 2019.

The suggestions / objections shall be filed in English or Hindi. Suggestions / objections filed in any other language shall not be accepted unless accompanied by authenticated translation in English. The suggestions/objections should be filed in nine copies and should carry the full name, postal address with pin code number, fax number and email address, if any, of the person sending the suggestions/objections. Alternatively the suggestions/ objections can also be filed through email to the Commission and HPPTCL (dgmcomm@hpptcl.in) along with 2 hard copies to the Commission. It should be indicated whether the objection is being filed on behalf of any organization or any category of consumers. It should also be stated whether the objector wants to be heard in person by the Commission.

The HPPTCL shall submit replies to the suggestions/objections on affidavit with 9 copies to the Commission by 16th April, 2019, one copy of which shall also be sent to the individual objectors. The objectors shall submit rejoinder, if any, to the Commission with a copy to the petitioner, HPPTCL by 23rd April, 2019.

The public hearing in the matter shall be held on 29th April, 2019 at 11.30 A.M. or immediately afterwards in the Commission's Court Room at Shimla, wherein the Objectors can present their cases in the proposed hearing. Stakeholders in general, may also participate in the hearing.
