PUBLIC NOTICE INVITING SUGGESTIONS/OBJECTIONS

In the matter of:

Petition No. 29 of 2019

The Himachal Pradesh State Load Despatch Society (hereinafter referred to as the “the HPLDS”) has submitted to the Commission the petition for approval of Business Plan and Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) for the Fourth MYT Control Period(FY20-24) under Section 62, 64 and 86 of Electricity Act, 2003 on 30th November, 2018. The HPLDS has submitted further details through MA No. 33/2019 dated 18.02.2019 before the HPERC. The salient features of the petition were published by the HPLDS in the newspapers i.e. “**Punjab Kesari**” and “**The Tribune**” on **01.03.2019** and again in “**Hindustan Times**” and “**Amar Ujala**” on **02.03.2019**.

The full text of the petition, under consideration, can be obtained from the offices of the **Superintending Engineer, HPSLDC, Govt. of HP, Totu, Shimla-11** on payment of Rs. 1500/- w.e.f. 2nd March, 2019. Interested parties are also free to see, examine and inspect the detailed compilation at office of Superintending Engineer, HPLDS during office hours on any working day. As required under Section 64(3) of the Electricity Act, 2003, the HPERC hereby invites suggestions and objections in the matter from the interested parties. Suggestions/objections on the issues together with relevant data, details and copies of documents, if any, in support of the suggestions/objections, be sent to the **Secretary, Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission, Vidyut Aayog Bhawan, Block No. 37, SDA Complex, Kasumpti, Shimla-171009** along with proof of service of the same to the **Superintending Engineer, HPSLDC, Govt. of HP, Totu, Shimla-11** by **30th March, 2019**.

The suggestions / objections shall be filed in English or Hindi. Suggestions / objections filed in any other language shall not be accepted unless accompanied by authenticated translation in English. The suggestions/objections should be filed in nine copies and should carry the full name, postal address with pin code number, fax number and email address, if any, of the person sending the suggestions/objections. Alternatively the suggestions/ objections can also be filed through email to the Commission (hperc@rediffmail.com) and HPLDS (sehpslhc@gmail.com) along with 2 hard copies to the Commission. It should be indicated whether the objection is being filed on behalf of any organization or any category of consumers. It should also be stated whether the objector wants to be heard in person by the Commission.

The HPSLDC shall submit replies to the suggestions/objections on affidavit with 9 copies to the Commission by **16th April, 2019**, one copy of which shall also be sent to the individual objectors. The objectors shall submit rejoinder, if any, to the Commission with a copy to the petitioner, HPLDS by **23rd April, 2019**.

The public hearing in the matter shall be held on **29th April, 2019** at **11.30 A.M.** or immediately afterwards in the Commission’s Court Room at Shimla, wherein the Objectors can present their cases in the proposed hearing. Stakeholders in general, may also participate in the hearing.
