This is a Petition filed by the Petitioner for unpaid ARR Bills from COD onwards of 33/132 kV GIS Sub-station at Pandoh alongwith LILO of one circuit of 132 kV D/C Kangoo Bajaura Transmission Line (Asset-1) and additional 33/132 kV, 25/31.5 MVA transformer with associated GIS at 33/132 kV at Pandoh (Asset-2).

The petitioner has deposited only a fee of Rs. 40,000 whereas as per the HPERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2005, the Petitioner is required to pay the prescribed fee of Rs. 2,50,000/-. Thus, there is deficiency in fee of Rs. 2,10,000/-.

The Petitioner is directed to deposit deficient fee of Rs. 2,10,000/within a week.

The Respondent is also directed to file the reply within two weeks with advance copy to the Petitioner. Rejoinder, if any, shall be filed within a week after receipt of copy of reply.
