DAILY ORDER

No reply filed by the Respondent.

Sh. Kamlesh Saklani, Authorised Representative for the Respondent seeks two weeks time for filing reply that the HPSEBL has assailed the order of the Commission dated 26.12.2024 passed in Miscellaneous Application No. 172 of 2024 before the Hon'ble APTEL.

Sh. Shrawan Dogra, Ld. Sr. Advocate submits that the Respondent/ HPSEBL has not been making the compliance of the Order of the Commission dated 26.12.2024 despite repeated requests by the Petitioner and, therefore, a CMPMO No. 153 of 2025 was filed before the Hon'ble High Court which has been disposed off by the Hon'ble High Court on 11.04.2025 directing the Commission to decide the case finally on 25.04.2025. Further, the Hon'ble High Court has also directed that till the decision, the Respondent/ HPSEBL shall not insist upon the Petitioner for the payment of bill to the extent of amount claimed by the Petitioner in terms of the order passed by the Commission.

Sh. Shrawan Dogra, Ld. Sr. Advocate further submits that in exercise of the powers under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003, action be taken against the Respondent/ HPSEBL so that the compliance of the Order is made.

We have carefully gone through the submissions and the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in CMPMO No. 153 of 2025. Neither the compliance has been made nor the reply has been filed nor the proceedings have been stayed by the Hon'ble APTEL, the Respondent/ HPSEBL is directed to make compliance of the order dated 26.12.2024 passed in MA No. 172 of 2024

within four weeks positively and submit the compliance to the Commission within a week thereafter.

The default in not making the compliance as per order of the Commission dated 26.12.2024 shall invite action under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 including the recovery of the penalty from the erring officers.

Let a copy of this Order be sent to the Managing Director and Executive Director (Personnel), HPSEBL for necessary action.

In the meanwhile, the Respondents shall not insist upon the Petitioner for the payment of bill to the extent of amount claimed by the Petitioner in terms of the order passed by the Commission on 26.12.2024 in MA No. 172 of 2024.
