Sh. Manik Sethi, Ld. Counsel submits that the total amount to be released was Rs. 77,00,000/- but for the differential amount the Petitioner be given the liberty to approach the Ld. Ombudsman in case the complete amount as per the order of the Ld. Ombudsman is not released and he be allowed to withdraw the Petition with the above terms.
