**Advertisement for the post of Chairman, HP Electricity Regulatory
Commission (HPERC)**

The Department of MPP & Power, Government of Himachal Pradesh invites applications from interested and eligible Indian Nationals for one Post of Chairman in Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (HPERC) as per the provisions contained in Section 82(5) and Section 89 of the Electricity Act, 2003.

The qualification for appointment of Chairman of State Commission and their terms of office and conditions of service are provided in section 84 and 89 of the Electricity Act, 2003, respectively. Salary, allowances & other conditions of Chairman have been provided in the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other conditions of Service of Chairperson and members) Rules 2006 notified on 30.11.2006 with amendment dated 6th April, 2017 and 7.1.2025.

As per Section 84 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Chairperson and the Members of the State Commission shall be a person of ability, integrity and standing who has adequate knowledge of, and has shown capacity in, dealing with problems relating to engineering, finance, commerce, economics, law or management. The Chairperson and the Members of the State Commission shall not hold any other office as provided in sub-section (3) of Section 84 of the Electricity Act, 2003.

The Chairperson shall hold office for a term of five years from the date he enters upon his office provided that no Chairperson shall hold office as such after he has attained the age of sixty five years, as provided in Section 89 of the Act.

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Those candidates who are interested and eligible to apply for this post may send the following information:-

(A) The Bio-data of the proposed candidate should include the following alongwith his/ her signature and date:

(i) Name

(ii) Age & Date of Birth

(iii) Position now held

(iv) Educational Qualification

(v) Details of posts previously held and experience in any of the fields of Engineering, Finance, Commerce, Economics, Law or Management.

(B) Details of any office, employment or consultancy agreement or arrangement which he/she has in his/her own name or in any firm, association or persons or body corporate, or in the names of any relative, carrying on any of the following business namely:-

(i) Generation, transmission, distribution or supply of electricity.

(ii) Manufacture, sale or supply of any fuel for generation of electricity

(iii) Manufacture, sale, lease, hire or otherwise, supply or dealing in machinery, Plant, equivalent, apparatus or fittings for the generation, transmission, distribution, supply or use of electricity and

(iv) Any entity providing professional services or any of the business referred to in sub-clause (i), (ii) and (iii) above.

(C) A letter of willingness to resign his/ her post and to join as Chairperson in HPERC, if selected.

(D) A declaration in the form of undertaking is also required to be submitted along with the application on the following points:-

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- (i) That he/she does not have any financial or other interest likely to affect prejudicially his/her functions as Chairperson, HPERC.
- (ii) Whether any criminal case has been registered against the applicant?
- (iii) Whether the applicant has been charge-sheeted for any criminal offence? If yes, details thereof.
- (iv) Whether the applicant has been convicted by any competent court for any criminal offence? If yes, details thereof.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by section 180 read with section 89 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (36 of 2003), the Governor of Himachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and Members) Rules, 2006, notified vide Notification No.MPP-A(3)-2/2003 dated 30th November, 2006 and published in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh on the 10th March, 2007 namely:-

Short title and commencement.

1. (i) These rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and members Amendment Rules, 2024.

(ii) These rules shall be applicable w.e.f. 29.08.2017.

Substitution of rule 4.

2. For rule 4 of the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and Members) Rules, 2006, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"4 Pay.- The Chairperson of the Commission shall be entitled to receive a fixed salary of Rs. 2,25,000/- (Two Lakh and Twenty Five Thousand only) per month as per the Central Civil Services (Revised pay) Rules, 2016, notified vide Notification

No.G.S.R721(E) dated 25th July, 2016, applicable from 1st day of January, 2016, and the Member shall be entitled to draw salary equal to the salary drawn by officer of Higher Administrative Grade:

Provided that if the Chairperson of the Commission has been a Judge of the High Court, he shall receive pay as admissible to a Judge of the High Court.

Provided further that if a person appointed as the Chairperson or Member of the Commission is a person who has retired from the service of Government or any other body owned or controlled by the Government, his/her pay in the Higher Grade Pay shall be fixed as last pay drawn (in the post which he/she have held prior to joining HPERC) minus pension in accordance with the provisions contained in HP Civil Services (Fixation of Pay of Re-employed Pensioners) Orders, 1988 issued by the Finance Department vide OM No.Fin(C)-B(7)10/84 dated 1/12/1988. The Chairperson or Member will also be entitled to draw annual increment on the pay fixed as per above order dated 01/12/1988.

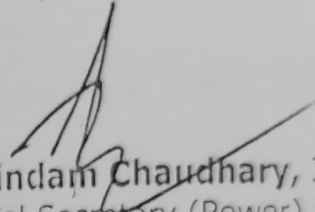

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 180 read with section 89 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (36 of 2003), the Governor of Himachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and Members) Rules, 2006, notified vide Notification No MPP-A(3)-2/2003 dated 30th November, 2006 and published in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh on the 10th March, 2007, namely:-

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) These rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and Members) Amendment Rules, 2017.
(2) These rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh.

Substitution of rule 4.

2. For rule 4 of the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission

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(Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and Members) Rules, 2006, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"4. Pay.- The Chairperson of the Commission shall be entitled to receive a fixed salary of Rs. 2,25,000/- (Two Lakh and Twenty Five Thousand only) per month as per the Central Civil Services (Revised pay) Rules, 2016, notified vide Notification No.G.S.R721(E) dated 25th July, 2016, applicable from 1st day of January, 2016, and the Member shall be entitled to draw salary equal to the salary drawn by officer of Higher Administrative Grade:

Provided that if the Chairperson of the Commission has been a Judge of the High Court, he shall receive pay as admissible to a Judge of the High Court.

Provided further that if a person appointed as the Chairperson or Member of the Commission is a re-employed pensioner, his pay in the prescribed scale of the post in which he is re-employed shall be fixed by deducting the amount of pension i.e. pay minus pension, in

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accordance with the provisions contained
in Himachal Pradesh Civil Service
(Fixation of Pay of Re-employed
Pensioners) Orders, 1988, issued by the
Finance Department vide OM No.Fin(C)-
B(7)-10/84 dated 1.12.1988."
