DAILY ORDER

Sh. Pratyush Singh, Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner seeks leave of the Commission to place on record the affidavit regarding integration and operation of telemetry system at the Petitioner's 32 MWp Pekhubella Solar Power Plant. Leave accorded. The affidavit filed and allowed to be taken on record. Copy supplied to the Respondents.

In view of the affidavit placed on record by the Petitioner, it is necessary to seek the following clarifications from the Respondent No. 1/ HPSEBL by way of affidavit:-

1. Whether the Project was connected to the HPSEBL system after synchronization till execution of PPA?
2. The detail of total energy supplied to the HPSEBL Grid from Pekhubella Solar Power Project ever since the synchronization till the execution of the PPA.
3. Whether the energy from the Pekhubella Solar Power Project has been utilized by the HPSEBL?
4. Whether the HPSEBL supplies generation schedule of each power house connected to its system or not?

Similarly, the Respondent No. 2/ HPSLDC is also directed to furnish the following clarifications by way of affidavit:-

1. Whether the HPSEBL/ Respondent No. 1 submits consolidated schedule or schedule of Individual Power Houses to the HPSLDC?
2. Whether the energy from the Pekhubella Solar Power Project has been accounted for in the total schedule of the HPSEBL by the HPSLDC?
3. Format of schedule supplied by the HPSEBL to the HPSLDC.

The affidavits be filed within 15 days with advance copy to the opposite parties. The Petitioner shall be at liberty to file the reply to the affidavits within 7 days from the receipt of the affidavit by the Respondents No. 1 and 2.
