DAILY ORDER

Office report seen. This Petition has been filed under Section 86 (1) (i) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with the enabling provisions of the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business), Regulations, 2024 for deciding the issue of category of tariff applicable to Jot Mix Plant of the Petitioner and for setting aside the notices dated 04.01.2025 and 03.03.2025 and restoring the power supply.

Heard. The Petition be registered as Civil Miscellaneous Application.

Sh. Bimal Gupta, Ld. Sr. Advocate duly assisted by Sh. Trigun Singh Negi, Advocate submits that the power supply to the Hot Mix Plant installed by the Petitioner at Diarighat, Tehsil Kandaghat has been illegally disconnected on 16.10.2025 based on the report of audit in a wrong, illegal and mechanical manner as a result, the Petitioner has not been able to operate the Plant and the heavy electrical machinery is lying idle causing great hardship to the Petitioner. He requests that the Respondent be directed to restore the power supply immediately as the Petitioner has already deposited 1/3rd amount as per notice amounting to Rs. 3,29,808/- out of Rs. 9,89,425/-. The Petition is duly supported by an affidavit.

Sh. Kamlesh Saklani, Authorised Representative appearing on behalf of the Respondent No. 1 and Sh. Chandan Sharma, Assistant Engineer, Electrical Sub-division, Kandaghat, Respondent No. 2 seek two weeks time for reply. They submit that the Petitioner is required to deposit the requisite amount as demanded vide notices dated 04.01.2025 and 03.03.2025.

Record perused.

The Petitioner has already deposited 1/3rd amount amounting to Rs. 3,29,808/- demanded vide notice dated 04.01.2025. Therefore, pending reply, the Respondent is directed to restore the power supply to the Hot Mix Plant of the Petitioner located at Diaraighat, Tehsil Kandaghat within two days on deposit of Rs. 1,64,905/- which will be 50% of the amount as demanded vide notice dated 04.01.2025. The aforesaid amount, as deposited by the Petitioner, shall be subject to the final outcome of the Petition.

Reply be filed within two weeks with advance copy to the opposite party. Rejoinder, if any, be also filed on receipt of copy of reply.
