DAILY ORDER

Heard. A careful perusal of the reply of the Respondent No. 1 shows that due to change of dealing hand and excessive workload, the requisite renewable energy certificates could not be procured within time but once the irregularity / infirmity came to the knowledge of the Replying Respondent, the requisite certificate were purchased from Indian Energy Exchange on 11.06.2025. It is also mentioned that the non-compliance was not intentional and that the Respondent will not repeat the mistake in future. It is prayed by the Respondent No. 1 that the proceedings be closed. The reply is duly supported by an affidavit.

It is evident from the reply of the Respondent No. 1 that due to inadvertent mistake, the delay had occasioned in purchasing the certificates but once the irregularity came to the notice, the requisite certificates have been purchased. It appears that the mistake was not intentional. A careful perusal of the record shows that no previous violation has been reported against the Respondent No. 1. Since, the compliance has been made, it would be in the interest of justice that the proceedings are dropped against the Respondent No. 1 for the non-compliance of the

Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Power Purchase Obligation and its Compliance) Regulations, 2023 with a warning to not repeat such lapse in future.

Accordingly, the Suo-moto proceedings are ordered to be closed with warning to not repeat such lapse in future.
